Dear Randy:

I am writing to summarize the work performed by Northwest Edison during the week of June 12, 2006 at our 750,000 square foot facility for the "2006 Mill Lighting Upgrades Project."

Your company provided us with direction regarding which lights to upgrade to receive the best payoff. After determining the lights to be upgraded, the bid price came in at \$47,402 plus tax for multiple areas on the site.

During the week of June 12, 2006, your company began work and overcame many obstacles. They had considerable pedestrian and employee traffic in some of the areas, hard to reach fixtures at 18ft heights where mobile scissor-lifts could not be used, and many picky people to accommodate during the installation.

Work was completed one day ahead of schedule with no safety related incidents or any other issues of any kind.

The results were better than we expected. The Lumen Output is considerably higher in all areas and has made everyone happier. The quality of lighting is much crisper than the old lighting. The energy savings with this superior lighting upgrade is over 310,000 Kilowatt-Hours per year. Most importantly, there were no cost over-runs. The project scope and cost remained on track from start to finish.

Your crew headed, by Dave Bolich, were courteous and professional. They took the time and effort to conduct work in a manner that minimized inconveniences to our mill employees. This project was the second project your company has performed for us. As with the first project in January of 2005, this project was a complete success in all aspects.

In summary, I highly recommend your company for this line of work.
